

Good Evening Families,

The Hazelwood team hopes you and your family is doing well.

First of all, thank you for your patience while we work across our district to identify how to best support scholars with remote learning activities during the school closure. Please see below for important information.

What is in-home learning?

Beginning on Friday, your scholar's teacher will send a weekly message (either using seesaw OR email) which will outline optional activities that can be completed in reading, math, and science/social studies for the upcoming week. Each week's lesson activities will be posted on our school website and some teachers may post additional activities using the seesaw application as well. While these learning activities are not a replacement for our classroom curriculum, we hope that the activities will be helpful to you and your family. Our school counselor, along with our special education team, will also post weekly activities to support with the social and emotional growth of your scholar. Our specialist team (Music, PE, and Library) will also post weekly activities that you can do at home as well.

At the present time, it is unnecessary to submit these assignments to your scholar's teacher, as they are optional in-home learning resources and will not be graded.
